## POSSIBLE MURAL LOCATION: $3^{\text {rd }}$ OR $4^{\text {th }}$ Floors

$3^{\text {rd }}$ Floor

- South Wall of South Wing corridor.
- $20^{\prime}-8^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime}-10^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Ht}$.
- Located between two (2) pilasters on South Wall and above the marble wainscot of $3^{\prime}-5^{\prime \prime}$.
- Adjacent to Anteroom of Old Supreme Court. Original and historic Supreme Court used by Judicial Branch from 1903 to 1976.
- Mural lighting mounted on ceiling (similar to all other murals) must be furnished and installed.
$4^{\text {th }}$ Floor
- North, West and South Walls of West Wing.
- North Wall $20^{\prime}-3^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime}-2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Ht}$.
- West Wall $24^{\prime}-0^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime}-2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Ht}$. Centered on West Wall are wood surrounds and a pair of doors to the Visitor Gallery of House of Representatives (House Chamber). Wood surrounds and doors will subtract $8^{\prime}-0^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime}-6^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Ht}$ from West Wall mural area.
- South Wall $20^{\prime}-3^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime}-2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Ht}$.
- Mural will be mounted above the marble wainscot of $2^{\prime}-10^{\prime \prime}$.
- U-shaped walls surround a hand rail at light well from $5^{\text {th }}$ Floor skylight.
- Mural lighting exists and is mounted on the ceiling.
