In 2008, the Special Committee on a New Comprehensive Transportation Plan, seven senators and nine representatives, was directed to study the need for a new comprehensive transportation plan. It conducted hearings in Topeka, Wichita, Overland Park, Garden City, and Pittsburg and concluded such a plan was necessary. The 2008 Joint Committee on Economic Development studied the economic impact of a new comprehensive transportation plan and found KDOT including future economic value of projects in its analyses.
